STEM Career: Physical Therapist

Did you ever wonder who helps people get back to full strength after an injury? A Physical Therapist is someone who helps people recover motion and flexibility

after an illness, injury, or surgery. Many work in hospitals or nursing homes, but others work in specialty clinics just for pain management and recovery. Some Physical Therapists even work for sports teams to help players return from injuries quickly.



To become a Physical Therapist, you'll need to study lots of science in school. You'll even need to get a college degree and become a DPT (Doctor of Physical Therapy).


It is also good to practice communication skills so you can listen to patients describe their injuries. There are lots of available jobs in Physical Therapy, and it can be very rewarding to help people feel




